Factfile

When is the by-election?

Thursday 6 June. Voting is between 7am and 10pm.

Where can I vote?

Either the Coach House at The Swan or the Youth Centre, Frome Road – depending where you live. See your polling card.

> I've lost my polling card; do I need it? No, you can vote without it.

Why is there a by-election?

To fill a vacancy on Bradford Town Council caused by the resignation of a councillor.

Can everyone in Bradford vote?

No, the election is for a new councillor for Bradford South, so only registered voters in the South Ward can vote - this extends north as far as Tory, Whiteheads Lane and Belcombe Road.

What are the options?

As well as Lib Dem Sarah Gibson, there is an Independent candidate, a Conservative party candidate and an Ideal Bradford party candidate.

So how has that worked in **Bradford on Avon?**

- We encourage local people, like Sarah and Jennie, who were not previously involved in politics, to stand for election, and we don't tell them how to vote - it's up to them!
- We work with key voluntary groups such as Streets Ahead, Climate Friendly Bradford, Dementia Action Alliance, BoA Business, the Preservation Trust and more to promote the best outcomes for BoA.

When leading the town council until 2017, we:

- saved the youth centre and the public toilets from closure by Wiltshire Council in 2016, bringing them under town council management and beginning the process of other asset transfers such as Culver Close.
- along with volunteer experts, wrote and submitted the Neighbourhood Plan, which protects our green spaces.
- adopted Climate Friendly Bradford's original proposal for carbon neutrality back in 2012; followed in 2019 by Wiltshire Lib Dem councillors leading on the Wiltshire Council commitment to carbon zero by 2030.
- achieved practical improvements to make our town safer for pedestrians.
- 🞾 renovated St Margaret's Hall in 2014 to create a multi-purpose space.
